

## **Organization and Processes for the Consultative Committee for Space Data Systems**

### **CORRIGENDUM 2**

The Management Council of the Consultative Committee for Space Data Systems (CCSDS) has authorized the publication of technical corrigendum 2 to CCSDS A02.1-Y-4, issued April 2014.

*Page 2-16*

subsection 2.3.3.4, 1st paragraph

- delete “nominated by an Area Director and ”
- After 1st paragraph, add

“At the time of WG formation, the BOF may propose candidates for WG chair and deputy chair.

NOTE – It is assumed that Agencies having interest in the subject are actively participating in the BOF.

For existing WGs requiring a replacement chair or deputy chair, the respective AD may propose a candidate. For both new and replacement chairs and deputy chairs, in the interest of fairness, the respective AD shall also invite the CMC via e-mail to propose additional candidates and potential resources. For new WGs, the CMC shall be allowed 14 calendar days to respond to such invitations; for existing WGs, the CMC shall be allowed 30 calendar days to respond. The respective AD shall determine nominees based on the proposed candidates, and final appointment of chairs and deputy chairs shall be accomplished by CESG poll.

NOTE – A single CESG poll normally approves formation of a WG and appointment of that WG’s chair and deputy chair.”

*Page 2-18*

subsection 2.3.4, 1st paragraph, delete

“appoint someone who is able to be chair, ”

*Page 5-17*

subsection 5.5.2.2

- Item c), change

“If the document number is known, the number only, consisting of topic, major subtopic, and minor subtopic (see 6.3) shall be entered (e.g., “727.0” for CFDP). If a document number has not yet been assigned, the field shall be left blank.”

to

“If a document number has not yet been assigned, a number must be requested (see 6.3.2). The number only, consisting of topic, major subtopic, and minor subtopic (see 6.3) shall be entered (e.g., “727.0” for CFDP). ”

- Item d), add at end:

“Estimated resources shall be indicated as staff months.”

*Page 5-18*

Table 5-1, delete note 2

*Page 6-6*

paragraph beginning “Yellow Books shall . . .”

delete “and Orange Book ”

*Page 6-17*

subsection 6.3.2

- change

“Area Directors should request a number assignment from the Secretariat ”

to

“document numbers should be requested from the Secretariat ”

*Page B-5*

paragraph beginning, “The Yellow Book documenting qualifying implementations and validation testing . . .”

- Add after 1st sentence:

“Information about the independent origins of the tested implementations shall be included.”

*Page B-9*

paragraph beginning “At such time as the WG has completed the development, . . .”

- replace

“Experimental Report”

with

“Experimental Specification”

- replace

“The WG chair is responsible for documenting the specific implementation(s) that qualify the specification for CCSDS experimental status, along with Yellow Book test reports relevant to their testing or for justifying why such implementation is either inappropriate or should otherwise be waived. The documentation of the qualifying implementation must include clear statements about its ability to support each of the individual options and features. If patented or otherwise controlled technology is required for the implementation, it must be demonstrated that the licensing process and fees are reasonable and non-discriminatory.”

with

“The WG chair shall assure that the specific implementations that qualify the specification for CCSDS experimental status are documented in an annex to the specification; that documentation shall include clear statements about support for each of the individual options and features of the specification. If patented or otherwise controlled technology is required for the implementation, it must be demonstrated that the licensing process and fees are reasonable and non-discriminatory.”
